

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

Continuum of Social Work Education

Baccalaureate (BSW)	 Prepare students for generalist practice
Master's (MSW)	 Prepare students for generalist and specialized practice
Doctorate	 <u>DSW</u>-prepare students for advanced practice building from generalist social work competencies
(DSW and PHD)	 <u>PhD</u>-prepare students to be scholars who function as "stewards of the discipline."


History and Context of Practice Doctorates in Social Work

1960's 1970's 1990's

20 new programs began between 1965 and 1975

Number of universities offering the DSW had surpassed those offering the PhD with 11 offering the DSW, 8 offering the PhD, and 2 offering both degrees Most social work universities in the United States were offering a PhD as the research doctorate. By the late 1990s, the DSW had all but disappeared.

Of those programs still in planning stages, most (9/52.9%) are planning a clinical focus, 3 general, 2 teaching, 1 administrative, and 2 others.






What is the focus of your practice doctorate? Please select all that apply.



Characteristics of Current DSW Programs










Research Requirements of DSW Programs








Eleven practice doctoral programs (100% response rate) participated in the 2016 CSWE Annual Survey and reported a total of 611 students. This represents a 122% increase in full-time students enrolled in practice doctoral programs since 2015.

There were 466 applications to the 11 programs that participated in the survey; 53.6% of applications were accepted and 87.2% of those accepted enrolled.

Rationale for Accreditation

- Accreditation of practice doctoral programs would protect and enhance the preparation of social work practitioners in social work practice.
- •This aligns us with the majority of other professions that accredit their practice doctorate.



ACCREDITATION

- The practice doctorate committee is recommending a diverse approach for the accreditation of practice doctoral programs that encompasses the broad scope of social work practice at the doctoral level.
- The accreditation process and standards developed will ensure that these programs can differ in their goals, curricula, and in the competencies of their graduates.



Framework for Accreditation

- Social work education at the baccalaureate, master's, and doctoral levels shapes the profession's future through four components:
 - education of competent professionals,
 - the generation of knowledge,
 - the promotion of evidence-informed practice through scientific inquiry,
 - and the exercise of leadership within the professional community (EPAS, 2015)



Framework for Accreditation

- The practice doctorate committee is recommending a framework with five general areas for program accreditation standards:
 - Program Mission and Goals
 - •Core Expertise and Skills
 - Explicit Curriculum
 - •Implicit Curriculum
 - •Assessment



Core Expertise and Skills

- Regardless of program focus, there is a core level of skills that doctoral practitioners should have
 - Scientific Inquiry guided by theory
 - Evidence-Based Practice/Scholarship of Application to Practice/Thought leader and public intellectual
 - Leadership
 - Critical Analysis of Policy, Practice, Research and Theory
 - Specialty area of practice



Requiring MSW

- Debate regarding admission criteria for practice doctorate programs
- Key is if programs should articulate as a condition of admission that applicants have a MSW plus practice experience.
- The practice doctorate committee is recommending the following for admission criteria:
 - Admissions criteria that are clear and transparent but may vary by program based upon program mission and goals.
 Rationale for admission criteria would need to be presented.
 - Evidence of mastery of generalist social work competencies (BSW, MSW or BSW with other master's degree)
